The twentieth Annual Meeting of the Canadian Philatelic Society, Incorporated was held on Friday evening, April 16th, 1948, in the Kerby Hotel, Brantford, Ontario, on the occasion of the first two-day Convention of the Society to be held outside the City of Toronto. Our hosts, the Brantford Stamp Club merit our deepest thanks and appreciation for a job well done.

Over two hundred members attended the Annual Meeting and Convention while more than 25% of the entire Canadian membership cast their ballots for the election of the Board of Directors for the ensuing year.

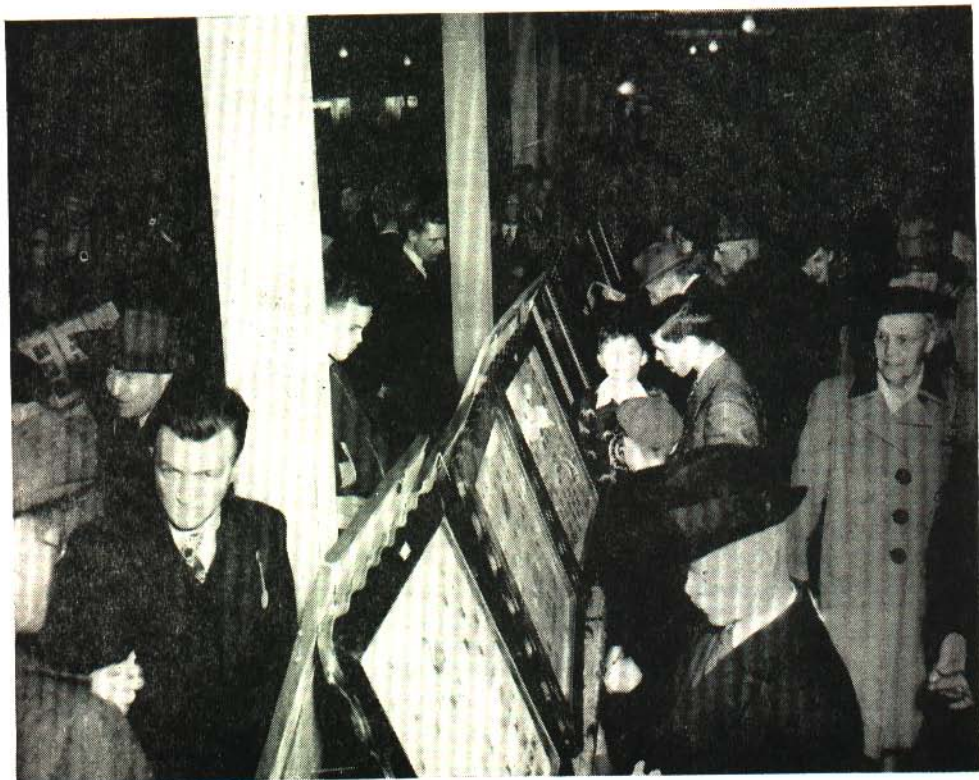
At the Annual Meeting, presided over by the President, Mr. Cyril Woodhead, many fine and interesting reports were read showing the continuous growth of the Society, the keen and active interest of the membership at large and the activities of many of the affiliated clubs throughout Canada. The President expressed his sincere thanks to all those who had cooperated with him during the past five

years in which time the Society had grown from a membership of a few hundred to 1,200 members residing in all parts of Canada, the United States of America and in many other countries. He had received congratulatory letters from members everywhere expressing full appreciation of the services of the Society.

The reading of the Annual Financial Statement prompted one of our oldest members, one who is associated with many Philatelic Societies in Canada and the United States, to say that the C.P.S. spends more on its members than he has experienced elsewhere. A condensed financial statement appears on another page of this Directory. Statistics for the past few years showed that our members were getting full value for the Annual fee and that no provision could be made to establish or build up a reserve for an expansion program of improved services. It was suggested that the new Board of Directors should give consideration to the matter during the coming year.

Printing and the Postage Stamp

To most philatelists the word "Printing" envisions only one branch of the art technically known as letterpress. Printing however is a general term covering all the various methods of reproducing either text or illustrations. Originally, a printer was frequently a combination of author, artist, engraver in wood or metal, a chemist who compounded his own pigments and varnish vehicles and produced his own copies. The underlying idea of course was to make possible a wider distribution of the text and illustration than was possible by individual writing or drawing by hand. Many different methods were evolved to attain this end but most of them for our purpose can be brought under one of three general classifications and a general knowledge may enable you to identify them readily. These classifications are Relief Printing, Planograph Printing and Recess Printing and the names are directly derived from the nature of the original or "image" employed in securing the copies.

Relief printing is the most familiar method and letterpress the usual technical term. The contact surface is raised and the ink used is of a consistency that, when applied, it remains on the raised surface only. This inked surface is brought into touch with the paper and sufficient pressure applied to ensure all over contact to produce a complete copy against a hard backing.

Planograph printing as the name indicates, is printing from an original almost perfectly flat surface. Instead of on the mechanical form to control the design, however, it is based on the chemical principle that oil and water do not readily mix. Lithography is the most usual form of this type of printing. Originally produced only through the medium of a special "litho" stone (obtained almost exclusively in Germany) which is almost precisely equally receptive to either oil or water, the design was put on stone while dry with a special ink or crayon. By passing a water roller over the stone, the balance of the stone was made ink resisting and the ink roller only deposited ink on the ink design, the remainder being sufficiently wet to repel the ink. The paper when brought into contact received the image. Today the limitations imposed by the scarcity of this stone have been overcome by "graining" zinc and aluminum alloys to make them similarly receptive, the surface after graining resembling that of "ground" glass. Offset lithography is a variation where the first impression is taken

on a cylinder covered with a rubber blanket from which it is "offset" onto a cylinder carrying the paper.

Recessed printing is a process in which the design is cut, engraved or etched into the surface, the resultant depressions being filled with ink and the surface wiped clean. When the paper is brought into contact with the surface by pressure from a rubber roller or other soft backing, capillary attraction draws the ink from the depressions onto the paper. Copperplate printing, such as is used for visiting cards and wedding invitations, is the simplest form of this type. Steel plate printing, which in Canada, is used entirely for the production of our Postage Stamps, paper currency and stock and bond certificates is another form. Today a further type known as Gravure, in which the depressions are etched by a photo-mechanical process, has come into general use and its use is rapidly expanding.

Postage stamps, being printed on one side only, are more readily identified as to method of production than is the case where printing is on both sides of the paper.

In relief printing considerable pressure is applied and, although a hard packing is used, (the packing being several sheets of paper on a steel bed or cylinder), the design practically always makes a slight indentation in the paper, which can be detected on the back if carefully examined. The poorer the workmanship the easier the indentation can be detected and in these days, with runs up in the millions, even the hardest packing becomes indented and this becomes quite noticeable on the printed sheet unless the packing is changed.

Planograph printing including lithography, does not make any mark or impression of the design in the paper whatsoever owing to the flat nature of the original from which the printing is produced.

Recess printing, owing to the depression forming the design and the paper being brought into contact by a soft backing, forces the paper into the depression and causes a slightly raised surface or a modified form of embossing.

The original purpose of wider distribution is just as great or greater an impelling force today, and each of these methods has both limitations and advantages not possessed by

OXFORD UNION SOCIETY

The stamps of Great Britain have always been favourites of mine, especially the line engraved issues. Early in my stamp collecting days, and that is quite a few years ago, I came upon a copy of the penny red overprinted in a brighter red than the stamp. This overprint was O.U.S. between two vertical lines reading up. For some years it was the only one I saw or knew of. The unusual in stamps has always interested me. So, it remained in my collection for some time. I did not know what it was or the significance of the overprint. It was, in fact, some years before I did learn what it was and what the overprint signified.

A couple of months ago, I was looking through my philatelic literature, and came upon some notes I had made concerning these stamps. Unfortunately, I did not make a memorandum of the source or sources of the information therein contained. As these notes contained what appears to be a very good check list maybe they are of some interest.

It has been said of Oxford University: "It was never founded, it just grew". Viscount Birkenhead said much the same about the Oxford Union Society when describing it he used the words; "Its origin is wrapped in mystery".

Debating societies are of course common the world over. But, the Oxford Union Society is perhaps the most widely known and the most famous. The society actually came into being on the 5th of December, 1825, when the first authorized meeting was called and held. It was in fact, however, a successor to an earlier society and the earlier society a successor to an earlier society or societies. You can gather that the idea behind its formation was the consolidation of the society on a university scale rather than perhaps college status of the earlier society or preceding societies.

While debating is its chief claim to fame, many famous men in British history have taken part in the debates, it has other just claims to fame as well. Among its other activities, apart from its social activities and ameties, it has a reading and reference library of over fifty thousand volumes. It is also a literary society of some considerable note. The greatest undergraduate honour is to be its president.

As I have said, many famous men in British history have taken part in the debates of the society, which though predominantly of a political nature are not exclusively so and do cover a very wide field. While the society has no official connection with the government, it has among its members followers of almost every known political trend, the decisions on the debates carry considerable

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weight and are often very widely published in the British press. Certainly success in the society seems on many occasions to have heralded success in British political and public life. It has been the training ground for many British statesmen. While primarily the debates are conducted for the members, visitors are on occasions asked to take part. The debates take place in the debating hall which stands with the other buildings belonging to the society in its own grounds just off Cornmarket Street. Procedure in the debates is in many ways strictly parliamentary, but a good test of ability seems to be not so much the precise presentation of facts and figures as the original and clear expression of facts; the epigram outweighs the encyclopedia.

Though there may have been some idea of publicity in the idea, I think the overprinting of the stamps was primarily a security measure. At the time it was started the Post Office was obliged to buy back any stamps presented for repayment. One can see how the "petty cash" box might suffer with this regulation in force. There is one point I have never been quite satisfied on as to the security idea. The records of the society and the Post Office are so silent on the entire affair they do not give any real help. The point is, as I understand it, the stamps were

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Try the nib on a piece of paper by drawing lines and lettering a few headings. When you are satisfied with your strokes and writing go ahead with your pages but do all of this work before you mount your stamps. Even experts make blots sometimes.

If you are about to letter in some headings you might wish to pencil in the letters first. Do this with a hard pencil so light in tone that only you can see the marks. With down strokes for printing or in your best hand writing print or write the name. You'll be surprised how easy, how neat your results will be. With the B-6 you can push the pen up the paper or draw it down with equal ease. The nib will not puncture the paper and cause a myriad dots from flying ink.

To draw either page or stamp borders it may be easier to pencil these in first. Then with a bevelled edge ruler, with the bevel side down, draw the line and lift the rule off carefully.

Two suggestions are in order. Be sure to keep the edge of your ruler clean and dip the pen nib in water and wipe it clean before you put it away. One ten-cent nib should last two years.

Now you can have more fun than you ever expected and if you really care to go further, buy one of the small "Speedball" lettering books for a few nickles. In it you'll find better instructions than you would likely get in an advanced lettering book costing dollars.

for the use of the members generally and sold to them, so how could there be any real check on their so to speak, wrongfull possession. I have never understood their possession or use was restricted to officials, specific or special persons within the membership of the society.

Permission, if any was ever actually given, to over print was apparently given in 1857 for it was in that year they first appeared. The privilege it appears was withdrawn in 1870 after which time the overprint (underprint) appears on the back of the stamps. The underprint is known both over and under the gum. The printing was done it would seem by the government, likely by the firms who produced the stamps. There seems to be no official record in the Post Office how the overprinting originated of by whose authority it was done. It is the only instance, permitted by the government, of overprinting on the face of the stamps of Great Britain, for private use. Underprinting was of course more widely used both as a security and publicity measure. The underprints of the O.U.S. ceased with the 1881 issue.

The overprint and underprint can be described as the capitals O.U.S. (sans-serif) between two vertical lines. The lines would perhaps be more properly described as wavy lines. Usually they read up but in the underprints they are known reading down or inverted. The inverts occur only in the wider spacing described in the next paragraph. To my knowledge inverts are not known in the overprints.

The overprints come only in one spacing with the vertical lines $2\frac{1}{2}$ mm. apart. The underprints occur in two spacings one with the vertical lines $2\frac{1}{2}$ mm. apart and the other with the lines $3\frac{1}{2}$ mm. apart.

The notes I had made give the following check list. The numbers are Scott catalogue numbers.

Reading Up—

#16 Overprinted in red $2\frac{1}{2}$ mm. spacing (it is possible it also occurs on numbers 16a and 16b).

#33, 33a, 33b, in red on the earlier ones and in bright carmine on later ones.

The overprint ($2\frac{1}{2}$ mm. spacing) has been noted on plates 71, 72, 74, 76, 78 to 93 inclusive, 95, 96, 97, 99, 100, 101, 102, 103, 106, 110, 112, 113, 114, 117, 119, 125, 133, 139, 150, 156, 160 and 205.

The underprint ($2\frac{1}{2}$ m.m. spacing) has been seen on plates 134, 174, 199 and 223.

The under print ($3\frac{1}{2}$ mm. spacing) is said to be known on plates 107, 119, 124, 134, 136, 146, 150, 155, 160, 162, 163, 164, 166, 183, 197, 204, 205, 212 and 213 (my notes

are just not clear on the point but might be with reference to plates 205, 212 and 213 they are only known as inverts).

#58 Underprint in red both spacings. (Can anyone supply more details, plates, etc.)

#79 Underprint (2½mm. spacing) in carmine.

#88 Underprint (3¼mm. spacing) in carmine.

#89 Underprint (2½m.m. spacing) in lilac.

Reading Down—

#33, 33a, 33b, underprint (3½mm. spacing) in red (? carmine) plates 205, 212 and 213.

As these notes were made some years ago it is possible some reader may now be able to add to this list, or make some corrections.

Why the government allowed the society to overprint stamps as they did is indeed a mystery. No doubt the society was a very influential body, perhaps some person just put one over. Equally a mystery, certainly as far as information goes, is why the underprinting suddenly ceased with the 1881 issue.

Though they were, it would seem, used in fairly large numbers they are not common. I think in fact they can be said to be scarce. Many of the underprints perhaps have been and are overlooked. The underprints over the gum no doubt have just disappeared in soaking, in many instances.

While these stamps are often described with, called and included with the "College Stamps" of England I consider it wrong to do so. In most instances, if not all, the college stamps were issued by colleges and not by the university, or body embracing the university as a whole. I refer to such stamps as for instance those issued by at least some of the colleges of Cambridge University. For example those issued by St. John's College Cambridge about 1884 and Queens College Cambridge about, I believe, a year earlier.

These college stamps, labels, or at the best locals were suppressed by the government. They were as far as I have learned nothing more than labels designating a fee paid for a messenger service. They had no official postal validity or value as did the O.U.S. stamps which were a government issue and had and gave all the rights of the postage stamps of the time.

May I say in closing I have always felt, certainly the overprints, are entitled to catalogue status. They could at least be given an honourable mention. Even the advertisements on the back of New Zealand stamps get a mention in Gibbons. The same firm goes as far as to quote prices on the "Pear's Soap" pennies of 1881. They are just as interesting and worthy of note and catalogue listing as the Maltese cross and other obliterations. My own opinion is they rank as high as the Great Britain used abroad.

Our Librarian, Mr. John T. Scott reported that few members were taking advantage of this service. The Library contains many fine books and much literature dealing with all phases of the hobby. Philatelic knowledge and research is essential to a better appreciation of the hobby.

The Sales Manager, Mr. R. Heenan, in his annual report of the activities of the Sales Department showed a decided increase in the amount and value of sales and the number of members buying stamps. This is of course accounted for by the increasing number of collectors joining the Society. Although there has been a noticeable increase in the number of members supplying the Department with stamps there is great need for many more to do so to meet the demands of those wishing to buy stamps for their collections. We regret to advise the resignation of Mr. Heenan as Sales Manager, who so ably conducted this Department for the past number of years. The Directors have appointed Mr. Ken Haigh, 30 Garnock Ave., Toronto 6, Ontario, to take over these duties.

The Chief Editor of the C.P.S. Bulletins, Mr. W. Christianson reported that he had received many letters of commendation of our Bulletin issues. He related there appeared to be a decided need for this medium of news service to the membership and he hoped to see it expand with the growing strength of the Society.

Adopted resolutions called for the appointment of an experienced philatelist to succeed the late A. Stanley Deville as superintendent of the Philatelic Division in the Canada Post Office at Ottawa; the destruction of stocks of obsolete off-centre stamps in the philatelic bureau at Ottawa; the appointment of a C.P.S. committee to collaborate with the Canadian Postal Department in the preparation of new stamp designs and the election of Mr. Cyril Woodhead to the position of Honorary Vice-President of the Society.

On Saturday morning a pilgrimage was made to the homestead of Alexander Graham Bell, the inventor of the telephone for a formal presentation of a frame of Bell Commemorative stamps and first day covers to the Homestead Committee. This frame now hangs in the living room of this fine old home.

Following the presentation a sight-seeing tour of the surrounding country and the City of Brantford was provided by the Civic authorities of the City of Brantford.

The highly competitive Annual Exhibition of Philatelic frames was held in a section of the municipal buildings. This exhibition proved highly interesting and was witnessed by more than 1000 local

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enthusiasts. A special feature of this annual show was the award of a special trophy presented to the Society by the Canadian Stamp Dealers Association for annual competition with a miniature as the prize, to the owner of the most popular frame as decided by the vote by ballot of those attending the Exhibition.

The frame selected by the public ballot was a well prepared and fully illustrated story of the history of Canada from the period of discovery through all the stages of development to modern times, all of our pictorial postal issues were used in the set-up. It was prepared by Mr. A. D. McMurtrie, member number 3603 of Sarnia, Ontario. This outstanding exhibit, selected also by the Official Judges, took

the others. First one and then the other would overcome mechanical or chemical difficulties and seemingly surpass them for quality, economy and speed. At first the inking and then the printing of the paper were done alternately and the bed containing the image moved to and fro under the cylinder carrying the paper which was raised out of contact while the bed returned. This "reciprocating" method involved a loss of 50% of the time and effort in reversing to its original position, and also the need of bringing the heavy bed to a complete stop imposed a definite limit to the speed that could be attained. A large press of this type on which one thousand impressions per hour in one colour could be obtained was considered the limit. To overcome these difficulties, machine made paper in a continuous strip wound into rolls was produced. The flat bed was changed to a large cylinder. The original was curved over another similar cylinder and by this means printing was produced continuously. This introduced many new difficulties. Whereas the flat sheets were racked out and permitted to dry, a continuous wet sheet had to be dried rapidly to permit handling without smudge. Gravure plates being only 1/32" thick were relatively easy to bend over a cylinder, and lithograph zinc and aluminium were also thinner and easily made to conform but letterpress plates are rigid and from 1/6" to 1/4" thick. Plates of this calibre when curved have a variation in size between the inside and outside circumference and a certain amount of stretch takes place in the outer or printing surface and some retraction in the opposite dimension. This accounts for the changed size in the printing of stamps produced on a rotary press from the same stamp of the same original produced by the flatbed method often listed in the stamp catalogues.

Since the introduction of the rotary method of printing and mechanical as well as chemical drying the addition of more cylinders has taken place and additional colours are printed on the sheet in almost instantaneous succession. Whereas in flat sheet printing each colour was permitted to dry at least a day or two before the next colour was printed, the rotary colour press required assistance of the chemist to evolve inks that could be superimposed while still wet. Four colours are being printed wet today with synthetic rosin base inks, the varnish vehicle burned off in huge gas ovens at the rate of one thousand feet per minute and then over refrigerated rolls to "set" the rosin base pigment, four more colours on the reverse, a similar trip through another oven, then over the refrigerated rollers and then folded, perforated, cut and delivered at this speed.

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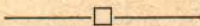
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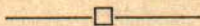
