1. Meeting opened at 6:30

2. Communications:

-Jan Hofmeyer sends his regrets on accepting the International Liaison Chair

- -Murray Bialek suggested that The Royal for 2027 (Calgary) be a joint exhibition with BNAPS. There was a consensus in favour to this suggestion.
- -Harold Kirsche suggested a collaboration/ties between Canadian Philatelic organizations for instance The APS, German Philatelic Society etc.
- -Don Hedger expressed concern about a recent President's Message. President Gregg contacted him without resolution. Hedger is not a member of the RPSC.
